



Flag Football Volunteer Job Descriptions

Timekeeper

1. Become familiar with the stop watch...how to stop, start and reset.
2. Clock counts up to 20 minutes for each half. Teams and officials cannot see the clock obviously so Timer needs to give appropriate updates throughout each half especially near the end of a half or game.
3. Before game go over #4 and #5 below with officials to make sure you are on the same page. Official may choose to keep the clock on the field.
4. Clock WILL NOT stop in first half except for an official time out or team time out.
5. Clock WILL stop in the second half under 1 minute for normal game stoppages.
Under a minute: Clock Stops for out of bounds, incomplete pass, time out, official time-out. Restarts on the snap. After a first down the clock stops until the referee sets the ball for play.
6. TIME OUTS: Each team gets one 60 second time out per half.
7. Assist scorekeeper to make sure score is correct.
